

> Transfer to Walsh College

Complete your undergraduate degree.

With a focus on upper-level, applied-business learning and real-world education, Walsh is a great place to finish your bachelor's degree in business or technology. We allow you to transfer up to 82 community college credits toward your degree program—offering significant financial savings compared to many four-year universities.

> Concurrent Enrollment

Get a head start at Walsh.

You can start taking courses at Walsh while finishing transfer credits at your community college. This is a great way to maximize your transfer credits and save money.

> Walsh College Honors Fast Track Program

Earn three business degrees in as little as five years.

The Honors Fast Track (HFT) Program provides for a seamless transition from an associate's degree at a community college to the Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) and Master of Business Administration (MBA) at Walsh. Students in the HFT program are able to complete their MBA as much as one year sooner than students who follow the traditional path.

Transfer 82 Credits to Walsh

Walsh accepts transfer credits from any regionally accredited institution. We have collaborative arrangements with many community colleges so your transition will be an easy process. You can complete your degree at Walsh College locations throughout southeast Michigan or online, whether on a full-time or part-time basis. Ask a Walsh College Admissions and Academic Advisor for transfer-equivalency guides for your college.

Concurrent Enrollment

Once you meet Walsh admissions requirements, you can begin taking Walsh courses while you complete your community college classes through the Walsh Concurrent Enrollment program. This is a great way to get started at Walsh while maximizing the transferability of your credits. Concurrent enrollment also offers more flexibility in scheduling—you can choose between courses available at your community college and those at Walsh each semester. To concurrently enroll at Walsh, just submit an admissions application (walshcollege.edu/ApplyNow) and meet with a Walsh advisor to sign a concurrent enrollment agreement.

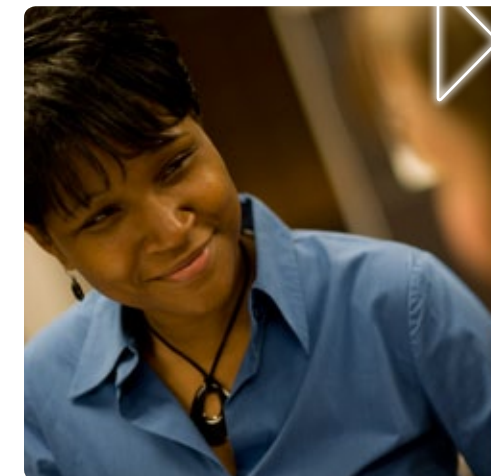
Planning Ahead: High School Students and Walsh

When you know you want to finish your business degree at Walsh College, you can apply first to Walsh—even before registering for undergraduate classes at your transfer institution. Your Walsh advisor can help you plan your pre-transfer coursework to make your transition as smooth as possible.

Admissions Requirements

Most undergraduate students transfer to Walsh from a community college. We maintain a list of transfer courses from those schools and their direct equivalents at Walsh College. Other transfer credit is accepted in the form of general studies or liberal arts credit up to a maximum of 82 semester credit hours. All courses at the 100 (or 1000) level or higher, completed with a "C" (2.00) or better, are transferable to Walsh. Students are required to complete a minimum of 30 semester credit hours of Liberal Arts coursework, including a course in intermediate algebra (or higher-level math) and English composition.

As you plan your transfer, work with your Walsh advisor to ensure you maximize your credit transferability.

Honors Fast Track (HFT) Program Admissions Criteria Overview

Earn your Business Associate's Degree at a community college then transfer to Walsh to complete your Bachelor of Business Administration and Master of Business Administration—all in as little as five years. You can apply to Walsh College even before starting your undergraduate courses at a different college or university, without the need to re-apply later.

HFT Admissions Requirements:

- Complete a minimum of 60 semester credit hours at the 100 level or above, 30 semester credit hours of which must be liberal arts course work with a GPA of 3.300 or higher
- Complete one course in English composition or written communication and one course in intermediate algebra or higher level course/placement

The Walsh HFT Advantage

- > HFT students can complete an associate's, Bachelor of Business Administration, and Master of Business Administration in 150 hours—typically in five years.
- > The average student completes the three degrees in 177 credit hours, usually over six years.

Total cost comparison

Many of our undergraduate students transfer to Walsh from a community college, making their education more affordable.

Transfer to Walsh

Transfer school: The average cost of 82 semester credit hours from a Michigan community college at \$80 per credit hour \$6,560

Walsh College: 45 semester credit hours at Walsh, based on an average of \$320 per credit hour \$14,400

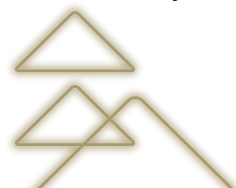
Total: 127 semester credit hours needed for a bachelor's degree **\$20,960**

Four-year Public College

Estimated cost of a bachelor's degree from a local four-year public college, based on tuition alone with average rate of \$357 per credit hour, 127 hours of instruction **\$45,339**
